Ready to enroll in Medicare? Here's a final checklist of what you'll need

Are you receiving your Social Security benefits? If so, you'll be automatically enrolled in Original Medicare (Parts A and B) the first day of the month you turn 65. But if you choose to delay getting Social Security payments until after age 65 you will not be automatically enrolled. You'll need to have some information ready to begin your enrollment in Medicare.

So, what do you need to begin your application? To sign up you may be asked for:

- Proof of your age
- Your work history
- · Your citizenship or permanent resident status

Are you interested in enrolling in coverage through a Medicare Advantage plan? If so, you'll need to provide some more information once you've signed up for Original Medicare.

What you may need

When you join a Medicare Advantage plan, you'll have to give these **extra items**:

- Your Medicare number (you can find this information on your Medicare card)
- The name of the Medicare Advantage plan you've selected
